We are proceeding with the necessary paperwork and waiting for a response. A financial campaign will be announced in the fall.

INDIGENOUS GUEST SPEAKER

Dr. Blair Stonechild, Professor of Indigenous Studies, First Nations University of Canada (FNUC), has kindly accepted an invitation to speak at First Church on Sunday, May 7, on the topic of "reconciliation" during the coffee hour immediately following the morning service.

Blair is a member of the Muscowpetung First Nation and is a residential school survivor. His research interests include Indigenous spirituality and Indian residential schooling. He has recently designed a new course on residential schooling and reconciliation which he will be teaching at FNUC. His book, *The Knowledge Seeker: Embracing Indigenous Spirituality*, was published last year by the University of Regina Press.

This is a wonderful opportunity for us to learn more about "reconciliation" from a First Nations perspective, and how churches might respond to or help advance the processes of reconciliation.

Also, Sunday, May 7, has appropriately been designated by Session as our Healing and Reconciliation Sunday for this year

Please make a note of this date and, if at all possible, plan to attend both the service and the talk by Professor Stonechild that immediately follows in the gymnasium.

A light lunch is being planned for the occasion.
